Locations: Chiplun, Ratnagiri

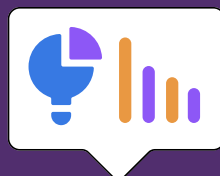
Beneficiaries: 66

To improve the quality of life and standard of living of the workers employed in building and construction works, “Maharashtra Building & Other Construction Workers Welfare Board” is formed. This Board is constituted of members which are government representatives. The main aim of this board is to successfully implement all the schemes related to building and other construction workers and improve conditions in the labor-intensive industry. Construction workers or laborers constitute a very large part of our society. However, there is no track of these workers. TWJ Foundation helps construction workers to get registered and avail themselves of the benefits of these schemes. 60 beneficiaries have registered through us till now. Out of which 10 beneficiaries have been provided with safety kit through Construction workers essential kit benefit scheme by Maharashtra Government.

Business Guidance

Locations: Ratnagiri and Yavatmal
Beneficiaries: 120



Rural entrepreneurship plays a very vital role in a country's economic development by creating jobs, increasing income levels, and improving living standards in rural areas. It also helps to develop backward regions, reduce poverty, and slow down rural-urban migration. To give a support to this segment, business guidance workshop and bank loan process seminar are conducted for the women of self-help groups.

The program provided detailed information about the various occupations that women can pursue at the village level. Officers from Banks explain the concept of capital, how banks raise capital for businesses, the process involved, and how to start a small business.





Mental Health admission

Locations: Shir, Ratnagiri



On 3rd August 2024, it was reported to us that there is a mental patient in the family at Shir village in Guhagar taluka of Ratnagiri District. The Sarpanch, Sub-Sarpanch, Police Patil of the Gram Panchayat were brought along, and the brother of the mental patient was called to the Gram Panchayat and guided regarding the process. People in the village were suffering a lot because of this mental patient. such as damage to property, public nuisance, attacking and threat to the individuals.

After guiding the brother, on 06/08/2024, this patient was admitted to the Regional Mental Hospital, Ratnagiri, as per all the planning and guidance, and this person was admitted to the Regional Mental Hospital.

Along with this, Mental Health Awareness camps are conducted at colleges. Mental health awareness equips students with the knowledge and skills to manage their emotions, reduce stigma, and seek help when needed. It enhances their overall well-being, making them better learners and individuals.

2 Hours for village

When it comes to environmental sustainability, we often see people complaining about others being irresponsible and blaming big corporates for pollution. However, making our planet livable and promotion of sustainable ecosystem is the responsibility of all of us. Knowing every individual's responsibility, an innovative initiative has been adopted by the villagers of Kumathe village in Satara district. Villagers from Kumathe have pledged to contribute 2 hours per week for the betterment of the village. In the month of August 2024, plantation drives were conducted by villagers. To work for this initiative, all the villagers including school and college students, women and men come together on Sunday and conduct various activities for the village. The plantation of more than 200 trees has been done in the village along with covering them with the protection net. Other required support is provided by NGOs like Paani Foundation, SayTrees, and people from this village. This small contribution by every individual leads to the big success and transformation of the village.

Since its inception, the TWJ Foundation has been actively involved in supporting the community through various healthcare activities. Our work initially involved the distribution of arsenic album tablets during the pandemic and has continued since then. The primary objective of our healthcare team is to emphasize that prevention is better than cure, and that no one should be deprived of healthcare services. We are committed to providing affordable healthcare services for all. With these objectives in mind, we have conducted 7 general health checkup camps at various schools, colleges, and community gathering areas in the Ratnagiri and Yavatmal districts. In August 2024, more than 550 individuals benefited from these camps.
